



VENDOR CONTRACT

All Payments should be made to The Sierra Mono Museum. Money Orders and Cash Only – Checks will not be accepted.

BOOTH FEE FOR TWO-DAY EVENT:

Information and Non-Profit Group:	\$50
Food Booths	\$200 + \$50 refundable deposit
Native American Craft and Novelty	\$125 + \$50 refundable deposit

BOOTH FEES are non-refundable and must be paid by the day of Event with a money order. Please include the \$50 deposit as a separate check if you expect immediate refund on Sunday.

VENDOR PASSES: **Two (2) vendor passes per agreement will be issued.** All persons 13 years of age and older must purchase admission tickets at front gate. Pre-sale tickets may be purchased through Royal Contestants and/or the museum office. Presale ends the Monday prior to the event. No exceptions can be made.

UPON FULL PAYMENT: A booth space will be assigned to you. Specific requests of booth locations will be acknowledged on a first come, first served basis. Your \$50 deposit will be refunded if your space is left in same condition it was in prior to your arrival and utilities were not used. All trash must be in waste containers.

ALL PERMITS MUST BE CURRENT AND DISPLAYED The Sierra Mono Museum is not responsible for any dispute between vendor and any government agency for any reason at any time.

CRAFT VENDORS: All craft vendors should have Native American theme. The Department of Fish & Game regulations require that wild game or animal parts are not to be sold without special State & Federal Permits. You must have a current seller's permit: CONTACT STATE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION (559) 440-5330

FOOD VENDORS: Must have a current Health Permit from the County of Madera Environmental Health Department INFORMATION: (559) 675-7823 Please include your Health Permit with your Vendor Application. The Museum must have your application for vendor space by July 15th.

ALL BOOTH SIZES ARE 13 X 13'. Vendors must bring their own set-up, generator, shade, table, chairs, etc. Vendors whose space exceeds 12 x 12' will be asked to pay for an additional space and deposit fee.

ELECTRICITY: Will not be provided. Please bring your own generator.

You will NOT be allowed to set up BEFORE 5:00 pm, the Friday before the event. You will be asked to wait. No exceptions.

Gates close and premises must be vacated by 7 pm Sunday Night.

The Sierra Mono Museum, Indian Fair Days Committee, and/or the Minarets High School will not be responsible or held liable for any lost, stolen, or damaged property or personal injury. Please be courteous to your neighbors and respect your elders. The powwow grounds are Private property – do not trespass.

RULES

1. ABSOLUTELY NO DRUGS OR ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS AND CAMPING AREAS, IF YOU ARE CAUGHT UNDER THE INFLUENCE YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OFF THE GROUNDS. THIS EVICTION WILL INCLUDE YOUR ENTIRE PARTY.

 - Camping is first come first serve.
 - NO OPEN FIRES of any kind while camping
 - Keep your campsite CLEAN. Please pick up all your trash. PLEASE PICK UP YOUR TRASH BAGS AT THE INFORMATION BOOTH

5. Please be courteous to your neighbors and remember to RESPECT YOUR ELDERS!
6. You are responsible for YOUR children at ALL TIMES!
7. The area surrounding the Pow Wow ground is private property. PLEASE DO NOT TRESPASS!
8. The Sierra Mono Museum and the Minarets High School are not responsible for theft, accidents, or injuries.
9. Motor homes must have a generator. No Plug Ins will be allowed.
